If more than two teams finish in a tie, the same criteria will be applied to reduce the number of teams tied from the top, and then the process will commence again.

BC wins vs. BU, 3-0-0 MC wins vs. BC, 2-1-0 MC wins vs. BU, 1-0-2 BU wins vs. Maine, 1-0-2 BU wins vs. UNH, 2-1-0 Maine wins vs. MC, 2-1-0 UMass wins vs. UVM, 2-1-0 UVM wins vs. PC, 1-0-2 PC wins vs. UMass, 1-0-2

Three-Way Tie Breakers

37 pts. (Merrimack-Boston College-Boston U.)

34 pts. (Maine-Merrimack-Boston U.)

17 pts. with UMass getting two points via win (UMass-Vermont-Providence)

17 pts. with UMass getting two points via two ties (UMass-Vermont-Providence) with UNH as 1st place team

17 pts. with UMass getting two points via two ties (Vermont-Providence-UMass) with BC as 1st place team

16 pts. (UMass-Vermont-Providence)
