BU wins vs. BC, 2-1-0 UMass wins vs. NU (UMass wins tiebreaker with BC and BU in 1st) UML wins vs. BU, 2-1-0 UML wins vs. Maine, 2-1-0 MC wins vs. Maine, 2-0-1 UNH wins vs. UMass, 2-1-0 UNH wins vs. PC, 3-0-0 PC wins vs. UMass, 2-0-1

Boston College (37 points, vs Vermont)

Seeded 1st with a win or a tie. Seeded 1st with a loss and a Boston University loss or tie. Seeded 2nd with a loss and a Boston University win.

Boston University (35 points, at Northeastern)

Seeded 1st with a win and a Boston College loss. Seeded 2nd with a win and a Boston College win or tie. Seeded 2nd with a tie. Seeded 2nd with a loss and a UMass Lowell loss or tie.

Seeded 3rd with a loss and a UMass Lowell win.

UMass Lowell (33 points, vs Providence)

Seeded 2nd with a win and a Boston University loss. Seeded 3rd with a win and a Boston University win or tie. Seeded 3rd with a loss or a tie.

Maine (30 points, vs New Hampshire)

Seeded 4th with a win. Seeded 4th with a tie and a Merrimack loss or tie. Seeded 4th with a loss and a Merrimack loss. Seeded 5th with a tie and a Merrimack win. Seeded 5th with a loss and a Merrimack win or tie.

Merrimack (29 points, vs Massachusetts)

Seeded 4th with a win and a Maine loss or tie. Seeded 4th with a tie and a Maine loss. Seeded 5th with a win and a Maine win. Seeded 5th with a tie and a Main win or tie. Seeded 5th with a loss.

New Hampshire (24 points, at Maine)

Seeded 6th with a win or a tie. Seeded 6th with a loss and a Providence loss or tie. Seeded 7th with a loss and a Providence win.

Providence (23 points, at UMass Lowell)

Seeded 6th with a win and a New Hampshire loss. Seeded 7th with a win and a New Hampshire win or tie. Seeded 7th with a tie. Seeded 7th with a loss and a Massachusetts loss or tie. Seeded 8th with a loss and a Massachusetts win.

Massachusetts (22 points, at Merrimack)

Seeded 7th with a win and a Providence loss. Seeded 8th with a win and a Providence win or tie. Seeded 8th with a loss or a tie.
