Tie-breakers:

- 1. Head-to-Head.
- 2. Number of wins in conference play.
- 3. Best record against the first-place team(s), then the second-place team(s), then the third-place team(s), and so on.
- 4 Coin Flin

(If more than two teams finish in a tie, the same criteria will be applied to reduce the number of teams tied from the top, and then the process will commence again.)

Two-Way Tiebreakers:

UNH won season series with NU, 2-0-0 NU won season series with ME, 1-0-1 NU won season series with PC, 1-0-1 ME and UVM split season series, 1-1-0 ME and UNH split season series, 1-1-0

UVM and ND split season series, 1-1-0 UNH and PC split season series, 1-1-0 UVM won season series with UNH, 2-0-0 UNH won season series with ND, 2-0-0 BU won season series with UMA, 1-0-1

Three-Way Tiebreakers:

1. UNH 2. NU 3. ME 1. UNH 2. NU 3. PC 1. UVM 2. UNH 3. ND

Notes:

- Northeastern has clinched a first-round bye because either Maine or Providence can pass them, but not both.
- Since BU won their season series with UMass, the Terriers will be the #9 seed regardless of their result on Saturday night.
- Vermont and Notre Dame are locked into hosting a first-round game.
- Notre Dame cannot pass UNH because they lose their two-way tiebreaker, and they come out in eighth if there is a three-way tie between ND, UNH and UVM.

Playoff Format:

First Round - Single Elimination (Campus sites; March 7-8, 2014)

Quarterfinal Round - Best-of-Three (Campus sites; March 14-16, 2014)

Championship Round - Single Elimination (TD Garden; March 21-22, 2014) Semifinals on Friday, March 21 at 5:00pm and 8:00pm Final on Saturday, March 22 at 7:00pm
