All-Academic Team Honors 40 Student-Athletes Merrimack's David Breen is Top Scholar-Athlete with 3.91 GPA

Celebrating another successful season in the classroom, Hockey East is pleased to identify 40 student-athletes who have excelled off the ice as well as on it.

League officials instituted the All-Academic Team in 1989. To qualify for the team, an individual must achieve a grade point average of at least 3.0 in each of the two academic periods during which he was actively competing.

Freshman forward David Breen of Merrimack College was named 2002-03 Top Scholar-Athlete, an award given annually to the player who achieves the highest grade-point-average over the course of the season. A native son of North Andover, Breen attended Phillips Andover Academy prior to enrolling at Merrimack. Breen's 3.91 GPA edged the mark of senior teammate Lucas Smith (*Milton. MA*), last season's Top Scholar-Athlete.

A regular on the All-Academic squad, Smith is one of four seniors designated as Distinguished Scholars this year. Distinguished Scholars are those players that qualify for the All-Academic team in each of their four seasons of competition. Black Bear forwards Martin Kariya (N. Vancouver, BC) and Gray Shaneberger (Sewell, NJ), join A.J. Walker (Faribault, MN) of Boston College alongside Smith as Distinguished Scholars.

The Academic All-Star team consists of a forward line of Smith, Breen and NU's Eric Ortlip (St. Louis, MO). Fellow Husky Joe Mastronardi (Vestal, NY), a three-time All-Academic team member, is paired on defense with rookie Matt Collar (Plano, TX) of UMass Lowell. Frank Doyle (Guelph, ON) had the highest GPA among Hockey East netminders, as well as the third highest save percentage.
