Comments on the season to date and talk about your upcoming series this weekend?:

The second half I've been pleased. I've been happy with the way the team played this past weekend. Obviously his goaltending situation has become solid and we all need to have solid goaltending. We have had some great battles with providence and expect it to be the same this upcoming weekend.
