~ "SUN LIFE FROZEN FENWAY" HOCKEY EAST DOUBLEHEADER AT FENWAY SOLDOUT ~

BOSTON - Fenway Sports Group and the Hockey East Association are proud to announce that the "Sun Life Frozen Fenway" Hockey East doubleheader on Friday, January 8, 2010, is now sold out. Thanks to the incredible demand from fans of Boston College, Boston University, University of New Hampshire, Northeastern University and hockey fans throughout the New England region, tickets for the first ever college hockey event at Fenway Park sold out in less than a week.

Boston College and Boston University will face off in the men's game at 7:30 p.m., while Northeastern University and the University of New Hampshire will play in the women's game at 4 p.m.

"The public response to this event has been tremendous and it certainly reaffirms to everyone that interest in New England hockey is definitely at an all-time high," said Hockey East Commissioner Joe Bertagna.

"We are eagerly anticipating this showcase of the best of college hockey before a sold out Fenway Park, and are truly humbled by the fans support of this historic event," said Fenway Sports Group President Sam Kennedy.

The men's game between the Eagles and Terriers features the last two NCAA National Champions. The game will mark the 248th meeting in the all-time series in one of the most intense rivalries in all of sports, which dates back to Feb. 6, 1918. BU leads the series with the Eagles, 123-106-17. The Huskies and Wildcats rivalry dates back to 1975, one of the oldest in women's college history. The game at Fenway will mark the 110th meeting between the two teams.

New England Sports Network (NESN) will broadcast the men's game live from Fenway Park across New England. In addition, NESN will broadcast a pregame and postgame around the event.
