## SOARING EAGLES BOAST EIGHT STRAIGHT LEAGUE WINS

### *Overall streak for UNH Wildcats climbs to 14-0-1*

Boston College was picked to finish third in the annual preseason coaches' poll, but few could have predicted the Eagles would be sitting comfortably in first place at this point, on the heels of an eight-game winning streak in league play. Granted, they've still got two games left against three-time defending champ Providence and one against UNH, who has three games in hand, but they've positioned themselves nicely for the stretch run. They had a very busy schedule last week, with four games on the slate, and all ended in victory for BC. Scoring was balanced, led by Sarah Feldman's two goals and two assists, but it was Alison Quandt's 78 saves on 82 shots faced that made the difference in wins over Vermont (2-0), Northeastern (2-1) and BU (5-2 and 2-1). Boston University did manage a tie Wednesday at Brown, as rookie Gina Kearns notched both Terrier goals and goaltender Allyse Wilcox stopped 32 of 34 shots faced.

Northeastern, meanwhile, narrowly missed an incredible story at Providence, ultimately losing 5-4 in overtime. The Huskies scored two goals 20 seconds apart in the final minute of regulation (both with the goaltender pulled) to turn a 4-2 deficit into a 4-4 tie. But PC's Karen Thatcher completed a big day with the game-winner with just nine seconds remaining in overtime, adding to a goal and an assist she had contributed earlier in the contest. Thatcher was shut out in Sunday's 2-2 at Maine, but defenseman Kristin Gigliotti was not, scoring one goal and one assist for the second time in as many games. Combined with a 2-0 win vs. Vermont on Saturday, Maine emerged from the week's action with three more points in the league standings.

UNH only had one league game on the week, a 3-0 win vs. UConn, and also upped its impressive non-conference record to 10-1 this season with a 3-1 triumph vs. Dartmouth. Sadie Wright-Ward scored three of UNH's six goals and added one assist to lead the offense, while rookie Samantha Faber registered four assists. The Wildcats are undefeated in the last 15 games, with 14 wins and one tie in that span.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** BC completed league series sweeps of both Vermont and Northeastern this past week, and also had two wins against BU to win that head-to-head series 2-0-1. The Eagles have won eight straight games in league play ... Since the start of the new year, four different Eagles have scored their first goals of the season, including sophomore Colleen Harris ... The Eagles have 12 wins this season, tied for the team's best D-I mark ever, set in 2001-02.

**Boston University:** The 500 people in attendance at Sunday's BU vs. BC game was the largest home crowd of the season ... The Terriers are averaging 15.7 penalty minutes a game, the most in Hockey East.

**University of Connecticut:** UConn has struggled against ranked opponents this season, winning just two of eight games ... Kaitlyn Shain stopped 29 of 32 shots Sunday at UNH, but received no goal support. The Huskies have been shut out eight times this season and have been limited to just one goal on seven other occasions.

**University of Maine:** Maine leads all Hockey East teams with 35 power play goals on the season. Last season, Maine totalled just 20 power play goals ... With 20 points on the season, Kelly Law has doubled her career point total. Law and fellow blueliner Julie Poulin rank third and second, respectively, among Hockey East defenseman in scoring this season ... The Black Bears trailed the all-time series vs. Providence 1-19-2 headed into this season, but have tied the Friars twice more in their last three meetings.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH has outshot its opponents in 65 of 66 20-minute periods played this season and has been outscored in just seven of those ... Melissa Bourdon now has 17 career shutouts, but needs nine more to catch UNH's all-time leader, Jen Huggon ... Jennifer Hitchcock and Sadie Wright-Ward extended their shared point-scoring streak to 10 games. Hitchcock has nine goals and 20 points in that span while Wright-Ward has 10 goals and 16 points during the same time frame.

**Northeastern University:** Freshman defenseman Erin Reil netted her first career goal to tie the game 4-4 with just 27 seconds left in regulation at Providence Saturday ... Five of NU's last seven losses have been by one goal ... The Huskies are 4-2 this season when scoring three or more goals - both losses have been a 5-4 score.

**Providence College:** Senior Ashley Payton surpassed the 100-point milestone this past weekend ... 19 of 21 Friars have registered on the scoreboard. The only two exceptions are goaltender's junior Lauren Florio and freshman Stacey Scott ... Kristin Gigliotti netted her team-leading seventh power play goal in Sunday's 2-2 tie at Maine.

**University of Vermont:** UVM has suffered three straight shutouts and has not scored a goal in 217:59 ... Vermont plays its final non-conference game of the season next Sunday, when the Catamounts host Rensselaer. RPI is 4-1-1 vs. Hockey East teams this season.

## COMING UP ...

Running a furious pace in the new year (with games on 18 of the first 22 days of 2006), Hockey East calms down this coming week with just seven games in a more traditional three-day span. Despite the abbreviated schedule, all eight Hockey East teams will play at least one game, and each of the three days will feature a headline match.

There's only one game on Friday, but it's a big one, Mercyhurst at UNH. The sixth-ranked Lakers will try to put an end to second-ranked UNH's 15-game undefeated streak. Mercyhurst will be the highest-ranked opponent UNH has faced since toppling No. 1 Wisconsin on Nov. 27. On Saturday, the Lakers skate into Conte Forum for a date with the BC Eagles, who have won seven straight games.

Sunday's marquee match is the most classic of all women's Hockey East battles - UNH vs. Providence. The two squads have battled back-and-forth for Hockey East supremacy in each of the three years of the league's existence. The first meeting of this season will take place at UNH. The following Wednesday, the teams will rematch in Providence.

BU currently holds the fourth and final spot for the Hockey East playoffs, but UConn and Maine each have three games in hand and stand only two points back. That greatly elevates the significance of the BU at Maine game at noon on Saturday, and to a lesser extent the significance of the UConn-Northeastern home-and-home series as well.
