HOCKEY EAST HEADLINES

UMass Lowell earned a win Friday with a 4-2 decision over No. 20 Northeastern thanks to three points (2g, 1a) from **Scout Truman.** It marked head coach **Norm Bazin's** 300th victory as an NCAA head coach.

No. 19 New Hampshire swept rival No. 7 Maine, 6-2 and 5-2, at the Whittemore Center. **Liam Devlin** scored four times, including a hat trick in Friday's contest, and added an assist on Saturday for a total of five points. Rookie **Ryan Conmy** had four points (1g, 3a) including the game-winning goal on Friday and Saturday's primary assist on the decisive tally. UNH is 11-3-1 at home this season.

No. 1 Boston College swept No. 11 UMass in a weekend series. The Eagles' **Ryan Leonard**, an Amherst native, scored five goals against his hometown team, adding that output on top of a goal and two assists in Monday's 5-0 win over Harvard for an NCAA-best eight points.

No. 3 Boston University took four of six points from No. 10 Providence. **Nick Zabaneh** had a goal in each game while **Shane LaChance** scored twice in Saturday's 5-2 win. The Friars' freshman forward **Hudson Malinoski** as-sisted on the game-tying goal in the third period of Friday's 2-2 tie before converting in the shootout to deliver the extra point to Providence.

Merrimack and Vermont traded victories in Burlington. The Catamounts are now 2-2-2 in their last six league games, moving up into a tie for seventh place in the Army ROTC Standings. **Chris Theodore** scored two goals and had an assist on the weekend.

The Northeastern Huskies bounced back with a 42-save shutout from **Cameron Whitehead** in a 4-0 win on Saturday.

HOCKEY EAST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LIAM DEVLIN NEW HAMPSHIRE

Liam Devlin (Jr., F; Needham, Mass.) tied for second in the NCAA lead with four goals last weekend to help UNH to a two-game sweep of rival Maine. He netted a hat trick in Friday's 6-2 win before tacking on another tally and an assist in Saturday's 5-2 triumph. He added a plus-three rating and one block.



RYAN LEONARD BOSTON COLLEGE

Ryan Leonard (Fr., F; Amherst, Mass.) led the NCAA with eight points and six goals in a 3-0-0 week for Boston College. His output included the game-winning assist on Monday in a 5-0 win over Harvard and the game-winning goal Sunday in a 6-4 instant classic over UMass to complete a hat trick against his hometown team. His 14 shots on net were also second in the nation and he finished plus-six, second best in the country behind teammate Will Smith.



PRO AMBITIONS ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

WILL SMITH BOSTON COLLEGE

Will Smith (Fr., F; Lexington, Mass.) led the NCAA with a plus-seven rating and extended his season-best point streak to 15 games as BC swept No. 11/10 UMass and shut out Harvard, 5-0. He recorded four points, all assists, on the weekend and netted a goal in Monday's Beanpot game. Smith assisted on a goal in Friday's 6-1 road win and added a trio of primary helpers on Sunday. It marked his second three-assist game of the season. He also won 15 faceoffs.



ARMY ROTC DEFENDER OF THE WEEK

ALEX GAGNE NEW HAMPSHIRE

Alex Gagne (Jr., D; Bedford, N.H.) posted two assists and 12 blocks, the second most in the NCAA and most of any player who played just two games, as No. 19 UNH swept a two-game series over No. 7 Maine. He also recorded a team-best plus five. He tallied two assists and four blocks on Friday in the 6-2 win, while he totaled eight blocks on Saturday in the 5-2 win.



STOP IT GOALTENDER OF THE WEEK

CAMERON WHITEHEAD NORTHEASTERN

Cameron Whitehead (Fr., G; Orleans, Ont.) led the NCAA with 103 saves on 110 shots faced in three games last week, leading Northeastern to a Beanpot championship on Monday that included six saves in overtime to earn the Eberly Award as the tournament's top goaltender. He followed that up with a career high 42-save shutout on Saturday night.

























HOCKEY EAST WEEKLY TOP PERFORMERS

Gabe Perreault, BC (Fr., F; Hinsdale, III.) Scored two goals, including one game-winning goal, and dished out three assists for five points in a trio of victories for Boston College. He currently leads the NCAA with 48 points on 14 goals and 34 assists in just 29 games played.

Cutter Gauthier, BC (So., F; Scottsdale, Ariz.) Scored three goals and added two assists for five points in a 3-0-0 weekend for BC. He is the NCAA leader with 26 goals.

Eamon Powell, BC (Sr., D; Marcellus, N.Y.) Extended his career-best point streak to eight games with a three-assist weekend as BC swept No. 11/10 UMass. He assisted on a goal in Friday night's win and added two in a narrow victory on Sunday. Powell also blocked three shots on Sunday as the BC defense held the Minutemen to just 24 shots on net.

Nick Zabaneh, **BU** (Sr., F; Toronto, Ont.) Scored in each game of a 1-0-1 week against No. 10 Providence.

Cade Webber, BU (Sr., D; Meadville, Pa.) Blocked an NCAA-best 15 shots in three games for BU.

Shane Lachance, BU (Fr., F; Andover, Mass.) Netted two third-period goals to help secure a 5-2 win over Providence on Saturday night.

Lane Hutson, **BU** (So., D; North Barrington, Ill.) Potted the game-winning goal in Saturday's 5-2 win over No. 10 Providence and added another tally in Monday's Beanpot championship game.

Mathieu Caron, **BU** (Jr., G; Abbotsford, Alta.) Made 80 saves in a 1-1-1 weekend, including back-to-back games with over 30 saves in a 1-0-1 series against Providence.

Aydar Suniev, UMass (Fr., F; Kazan, Russia) Scored twice in the span of 29 seconds Sunday at Boston College to give UMass a 3-2 lead, concluding a stretch of 3:32 where UMass scored three times.

Scout Truman, UML (So., F; Lethbridge, Alta.) Helped UMass Lowell to a 4-2 win over Northeastern on Friday night with two goals and an assist for three points.

Jak Vaarwerk, UML (Fr., F; Clarence, N.Y.) Had two assists in Friday's 4-2 victory over Northeastern to finish the weekend with two points in addition to his 15 faceoff wins.

Ryan Conmy, UNH (Fr., F; Alexandria, Va.) Posted one goal and three assists for four points as No. 19 UNH swept a two-game sweep of No. 7 Maine. He scored the game-winning goal and recorded an assist on Friday in a 6-2 win, while on Saturday he posted two assists as UNH defeated Maine, 5-2.

Jakob Hellsten, UNH (Jr., G; Ljusdal, Sweden) Went 2-0-0 versus No. 7 Maine as he made 39 saves and allowed four goals for a 2.00 goals against average and a .907 save percentage. He made 18 saves on Friday in the 6-2 win, while he posted 21 saves on Saturday in the 5-2 win.

Gunnarwolfe Fontaine, NU (Sr., F; East Greenwich, R.I.) Recorded a four-point week with two goals and two assists, including three points (1g, 2a) to lead NU to the 2024 Beanpot title, including the overtime, game-winning goal for the second week in a row. He was named MVP of the tournament. He then recorded the game-winning goal in the Huskies' victory over UMass Lowell. He finished three games with seven shots, five blocks and a plus-two rating and now has 12 points (4g, 8a) in his last eight games.


