# HOCKEY EAST BY THE NUMBERS

- Hockey East teams have won 13 National Championships, including nine during the league's 35-year history. In those 35 seasons, Hockey East has sent 115 teams to the NCAA Tournament, more than any other conference, and 45 Teams to the Frozen Four.
- In the last 14 years, the league has sent 52 teams to the NCAA Tournament, 17 to the Frozen Four, and nine to the championship game, where five have won the NCAA title.
- 10 players from Hockey East have been named Most Outstanding Player at the Frozen Four. 66 conference skaters have been named to the Frozen Four All-Tournament Team.
- Hockey East boasts 11 Hobey Baker Award winners, 79 Top-10 Finalists and 17 Hat Trick finalists, including 14 over just the last 11 seasons.
- 45 Hockey East alumni have represented Team USA on the U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Team in nine Olympic Winter Games. 11 of those 45 have captured a silver medal.
- 18 alumni of Hockey East schools are now college head coaches, and 24 others are assistants at the men's Division-I level.
- 672 Hockey East players have been selected in the NHL Entry Draft, including 53 in the first round.
- 96 Hockey East alums played in the NHL during the 2018-19 season
- 53 league alumni have been members of Stanley Cup winning teams, and two have won the Conn Smythe Trophy as playoff MVP. Most recently, Zach Sanford (Boston College) won the 2019 Stanley Cup with the St. Louis Blues.
